From: Wooster, Ohio

Take US 250 E to I-77 S toward Cambridge

Follow from: Cambridge, OH directions to the 2014 Ohio Sheep Day

From: Cambridge, Ohio

Take I-77 S toward Marietta, go for 8.2 mi

Take exit #37/OH-313/Senecaville/Pleasant City.

Turn right onto Clay Pike (OH-313), go for 1.2 mi

Turn left onto Marietta Rd (OH-821), go for 7.2 mi

Just after small white block Post Office, turn right onto Rayner Rd (CR-12), go for 1.7 mi

Turn right onto Ray Lane (TR-96). go for 0.4 mi

You are at the Ray Family Farm and the 2014 OSIA Ohio Sheep Day.

From: Columbus, Ohio

Take I-70 E toward Wheeling, from Reynoldsburg/Pataskala exit, go for 57.3 mi

Take exit #169/OH-83/Cumberland/New Concord

Turn right onto S Friendship Dr (OH-83), go for 3.8 mi

Turn left onto Clay Pike (OH-313, OH-83), go for 1.0 mi
