The Global Studies Ph.D. program is the first of its kind at a tier-1 research university in the United States. It provides a unique interdisciplinary degree for the study of global issues such as conflict, immigration, human rights, environment, and sustainable development. The degree typically involves a field studies component, mastery of a second language, and the completion of a Ph.D dissertation.

## FELLOWSHIPS

Fellowships, paid teaching and research opportunities are offered each year to support students. PhD students are also eligible to apply for competitive UCSB campus-wide and departmental grants and awards offered each year.

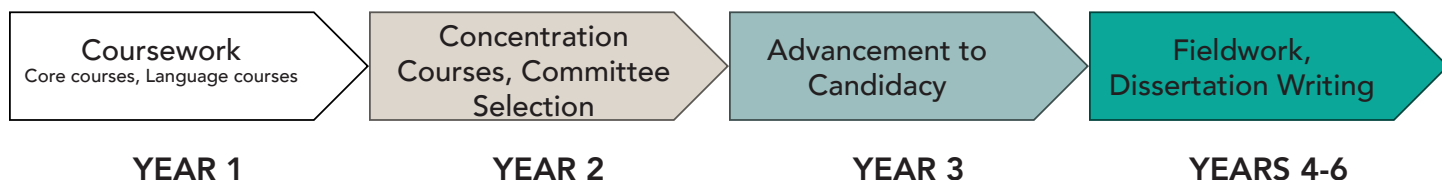
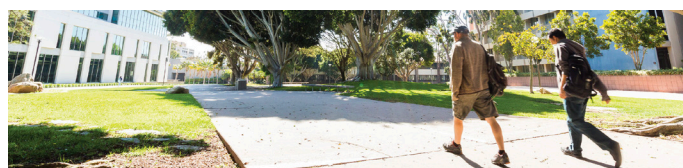
