May medical physicists count general medical physics continuing education not related to mammography or general continuing education in mammography unrelated to medical physics?

Yes, all continuing education credits related to the diagnosis or treatment of breast disease or other areas that will aid facility personnel in improving the quality of mammography may be acceptable toward meeting the continuing education requirement. Diagnostic medical physics continuing education not directly related to mammography or general continuing education in mammography unrelated to medical physics would also be acceptable.



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
