## The Personal Financial Management Certification Program

The Personal Financial Management Certification program is an innovative and self-paced program designed to equip higher education professionals and peer counselors with skills to facilitate conversations around money management and create dynamic financial capability programs on their campuses.

Program Overview:	<ul> <li>The program begins with a pre-assessment quiz to measure where participants are in their understanding of financial capability topics.</li> <li>Participants work at their own pace through 15 chapters of financial principles.</li> <li>The program culminates with a proctored final exam.</li> <li>Successful participants are deemed Certified Personal Financial Managers (CPFM).</li> </ul>
