The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (Service) invites your review of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), Draft Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP), and Draft Implementing Agreement (IA) for an Incidental Take Permit for the Buckeye Wind Power Project. The project consists of a 100-turbine electric generation facility located in an approximately 80,051-acre area in Champaign County, Ohio. All comments must be received by September 27, 2012
