The successful candidate will function as part of WEST's Bat Team and help design, conduct, and summarize results of bat-related surveys for a variety of projects ranging from wind power studies to pipeline and transmission lines, and other development projects. Species inventory projects on nondevelopment projects are also available.

Applicants can expect to spend approximately 40% of their time in the field conducting and/or leading surveys, with the remainder of time spent on office-oriented tasks, including but not limited to: writing, reviewing and editing reports, meeting with project managers and/or clients, database management and queries, acoustic data analysis, and other tasks as needed. Most seasonal bat field work will occur in the midwest and eastern U.S., but is not limited to those areas; field work in the southeast, southwest and northwest should also be expected.

Requirements:

Preference given to candidates that hold a federal endangered species permit allowing capture and handling of Indiana bats, or sufficient experience to be added to such a permit. Candidates must be skilled in the use of mist-nets, topographic maps, aerial photos, GPS units, and other field equipment as required. Precise and thorough data collection and attention to detail is essential. Radio-tracking experience is preferable. Experience with operation and deployment of acoustic detectors and with acoustic species identification is desirable. The successful candidate may conduct roost telemetry, foraging telemetry, and emergence counts. This work may require a person to navigate varying and rugged terrain safely and potentially alone in harsh weather conditions. The successful candidate must be physically capable of performing these tasks and generally be willing and able to tackle the rigors of field work while maintaining a positive attitude.

The successful candidate will be able to work well independently or as part of a team, possess superior technical skills, illustrate exemplary communication skills, and generally demonstrate the ability to do high-quality work in a fast-paced consulting environment
