Minimum Qualifications:

- Must hold, or have the required skills and references to be added to, a federal endangered species permit for the Indiana bat, gray bat and northern long-eared
- Rabies pre-exposure vaccination.
- Experience working long hours and extended periods away from home
- Experience working in challenging weather conditions
- Ability to carry heavy equipment long distances in rugged terrain
- Experience in various methods of collecting, recording, and analyzing field data
- Experience with mist-net surveys
- Experience with bat acoustic surveys (ANABAT preferred)
- Experience with radio-telemetry
- Must hold a valid driver's license
- Good communication skills
- Have a positive attitude
- Able to live and work well with others
- Must successfully pass a pre-employment drug/alcohol drug screen, random drug screenings, and background investigation.

These are temporary field positions requiring long hours. Site Leaders may work on a single project or travel extensively throughout the eastern U.S. depending on Copperhead needs.
