Acoustic Monitoring Techniques

This course is designed to provide the understanding and experience for developing a monitoring plan, deploying your equipment, and retrieving and managing data. It is meant to be a module also taken with the Manual Vetting Data Course.

Manually Vetting Data with or without AutoID

An in depth course teaching the characteristics of bat calls, how they overlap, when and how the bat produces them, and how to discern them from one another/defend a no ID result. Once these skills are practiced, we use those skills to work through the autoID outputs to understand how best to use both tools to their fullest. The courses are regionalized with a Canada/Eastern US, Deep South Eastern US, Western US, and Southwestern US. We are also offering Spanish translated courses on call ID. This is a module and meant to be taken with the Acoustic Monitoring Techniques Module.
