COURSES AND OUTCOMES

The gifted and talented education endorsement/micro-credential courses include:

EDG 621: Introduction to Gifted Education, fall semesters, 7 weeks

EDG 623: Teaching Creative and Higher-Level Thinking, spring semesters, 7 weeks

EDG 625: School Programs for Gifted Children, summer intersession, 3 weeks

EDG 627: Seminar and Field Experience in Gifted Education, summer session, 5 weeks
