## CLASSES BEGIN Fall 2021

Starting in August 2021, Xavier University will offer a gifted endorsement cohort at Springboro Community City Schools. Only meeting one night per week, students will take two courses during the fall semester, two classes during the spring semester 2022, one class during the summer 2022 (online), and the final practicum in the fall of 2022. Classes will meet on Tuesday evenings alternating back and forth between the two classes per semester. Every semester, there will be field requirements (some of which can be completed in your own classroom or district) and students will need a valid FBI/BCI that has been completed within the year.

The 18 hour program may be applied toward a 30 hour Master of Education or Master of Science degree in Special Education at Xavier University. These special cohort classes will be offered at a tuition cost of \$360 per credit hour (a \$205 per credit hour savings) and can go towards the above 30 hour degrees. If students continue with the completion of one of the degrees, the last three hours for the completion of the degree will be at no cost.
