Long-Term Substitute Part-time Gifted Intervention Specialist

- FTE = part-time (approximately 4.5 to 5 hours per day)
- Effective for 2021-22 school year
- Buildings: Clearmount and Northwood Elementary Schools
- Description: The K-2 Gifted Intervention Specialist (GIS) will provide cross curricular academic enrichment, build creative thinking and critical thinking skills, and support the social emotional development of gifted and talented primary learners. The GIS will provide formal gifted programming for identified students and will assist the district with gifted identification testing.
- Required Licensure: Candidates must possess either an Early Childhood (P-3) license or an Elementary (1-8) license.
 - It's also preferred, but not required, that candidates have a Gifted Intervention Specialist endorsement
- NOTE: This is a grant-funded position that will last one to two years
