General:

- In the near future, we will have recordings from the Zoom tutorials hosted by Terry Bradley. I want to thank Terry for her outstanding effort to pull that together in such a short time.
- There are continued discussions happening at the university level regarding guidelines for operation of research labs. I suspect these will emerge early next week.
- There is a new web site (keepworking.osu.edu) which has resources for people wanted to do more work remotely. This is analogous to keepteaching.osu.edu. Keep watching these sites for updates.
- General recommendations from the university is to reduce in-person contact and when there is in-person interactions attempt to maintain 6 ft of separation.

Teaching:

- With the extension of the online format and closing of the dorms, we must prepare for online delivery for the remainder of the semester. On a positive note, with the extension of spring break we have more time to prepare.
- The introductory course instructors and mangers are working hard to develop a coordinated plan, including how to run quizzes and exams. As these plans develop, we will communicate out the ideas that could be useful in other smaller courses.
- Instructional Continuity Plans: As Department Chair, I am requested to make sure we have a plan for every one of our courses offered in the department. Early next week I will be sending primary instructors a one-page document asking about your course plans. This will be just a brief description and/or bulleted lists discussing what you plan to do to deliver the course online, what changes are being made (subtractions and additions), etc.

Travel:

- The university has clarified its policy regarding domestic travel. Only essential business travel is allowed, regardless of mode of transportation. This travel must be approved by the Exec. Dean. This restriction applies to both employees and visitors. This restriction applies regardless of what institution is paying for the travel. At this point, please do not invite visitors to campus unless there is an essential reason and you must obtain approval.
- We have attempted to identify all personnel that are either in Europe currently or there in the last few weeks. In case we missed anyone, I want to remind you that most of Europe has a Level-3 Warning from the CDC. All travelers must self-quarantine for 14-days after return.
