Bio of Mr. Charlie Shultz: Mr. Shultz earned two B.S. degrees, Biology and Fisheries Science, from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in 1996. He has recently completed his graduate coursework and research on indoor lighting options for aquaponic food production and is expected soon to receive his M.S. degree in aquaculture from Kentucky State University. Mr. Shultz worked as a tilapia broodstock manager & laboratory technician at the Virginia Tech Aquaculture Center & as an aquaculture research analyst for 14 years at the University of the Virgin Islands (UVI) Agricultural Experiment Station where he specialized in Tilapia production in Aquaponic and Biofloc culture systems. Currently, Charlie serves as the Aquaponics Researcher at Lethbridge College in Southern Alberta, Canada. He authored or co-authored more than 20 papers (journal articles, publications in conference proceedings and popular articles) and has given more than 50 presentations at conferences and workshops across the U.S., throughout the Caribbean, and many other countries including Mexico, Singapore, New Zealand and United Arab Emirates. Mr. Shultz co-taught the UVI International Tilapia Aquaculture and Aquaponics Course 14 times and has co-taught intensive short courses in Puerto Rico, Arizona, Michigan, Tennessee, North Carolina, Singapore, Ontario, Alberta and British Columbia. Since 2006, he has served as an independent inspector for USDA organic certification (crop production).
