- Oasis Aqua Farm. Located in Beavercreek, Oasis is a local family owned and operated aquaponics farm. See how they produce pesticide free, "better than organic" vegetables, fruit, fish, and crayfish in their eco-friendly facility.
- Jones Fish Hatcheries and Distributors. Jones Fish is known as an industry leader in pond and lake management and fish stocking in the Midwest. They raise and sell over 19 species of fish in their Cincinnati aquaculture facility that we will visit.

This is an opportunity for attendees to see a wide variety of aquatic culture species and techniques, network with friends & fellow culturists, and ask questions of the operators themselves.
